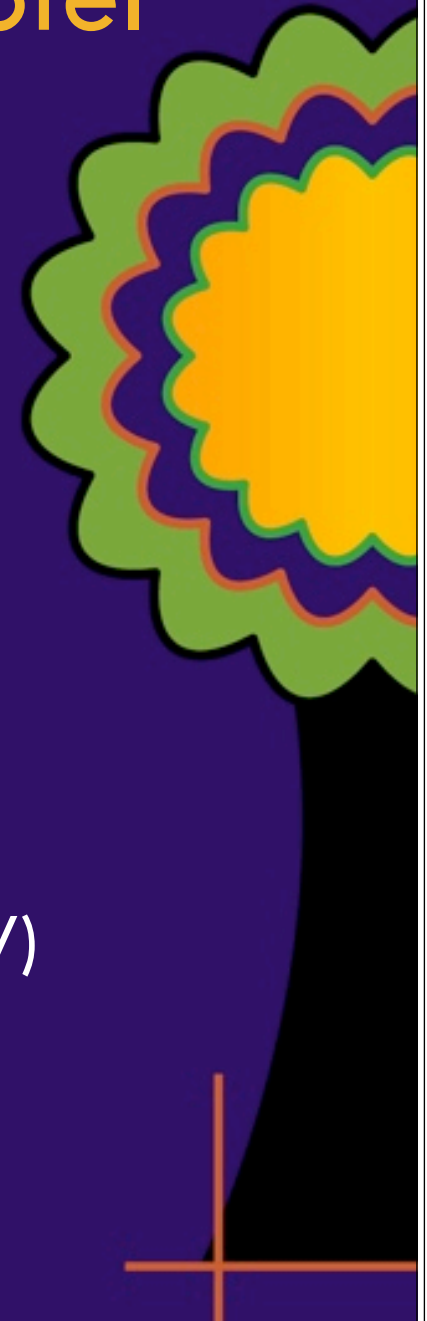


The Call for a HOME not a hotel

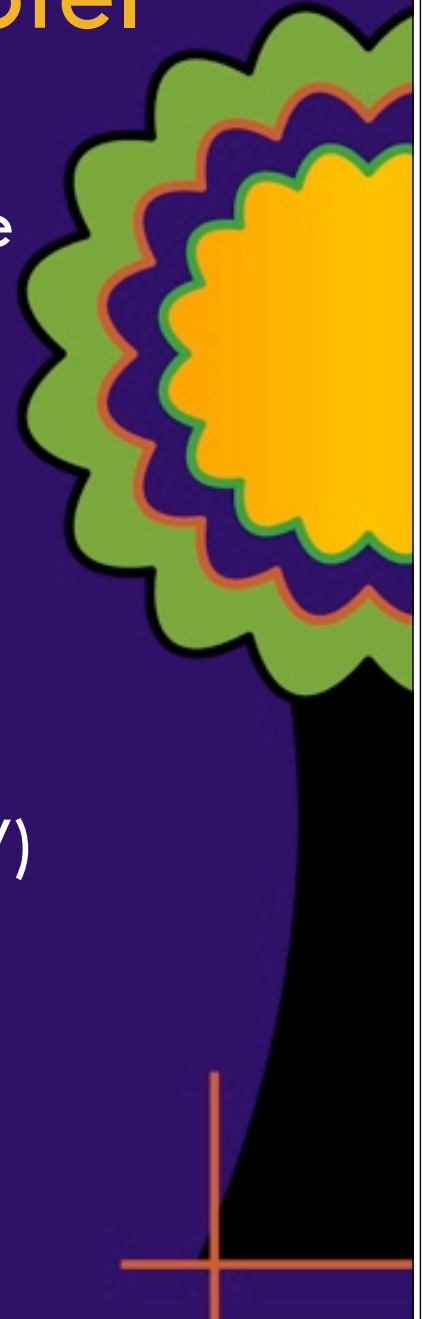

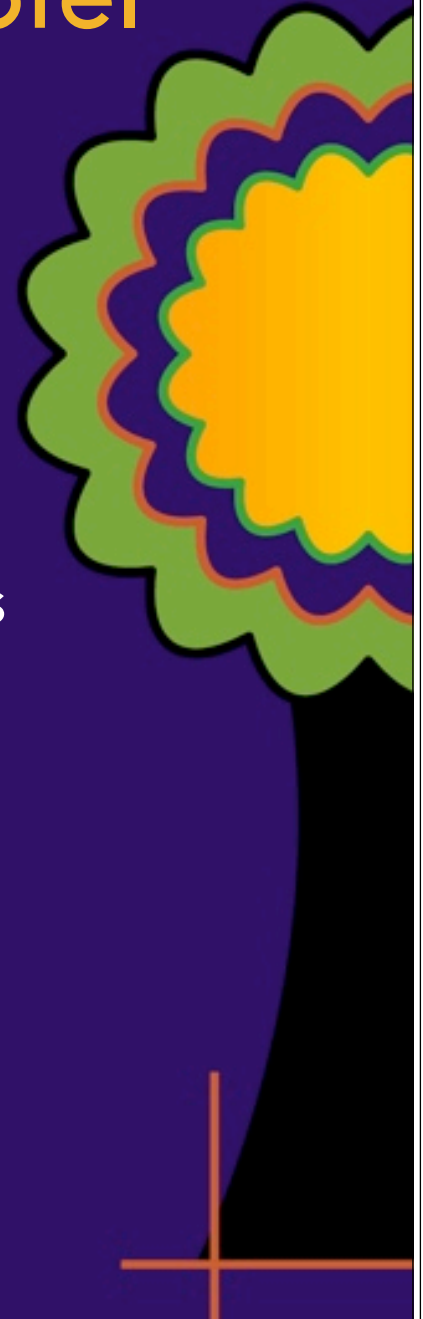

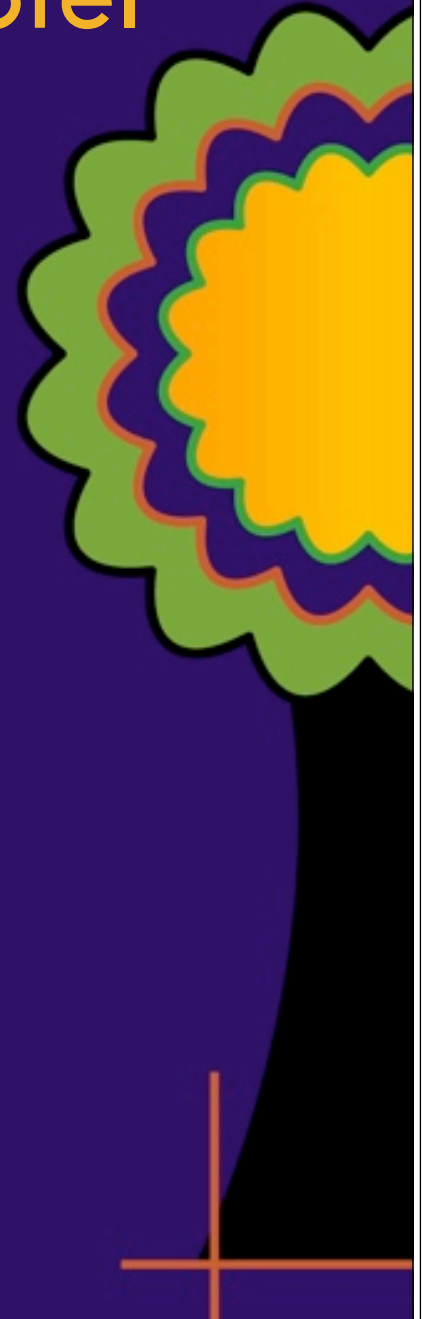
